

Whitley County Potential Project Areas

- South and West Sides of Churubusco- Connection to Churubusco Sanitary Sewer-Approximately 36 homes, 1 church on the West side; 115 homes and 6 businesses on the South.
- 2. **Coesse** Connection to existing sanitary sewer and newly built sewer- approximately 37 homes and the fire department.
- 3. **Dunfee-** Connection to Aqua Indiana- 10 houses and 2 businesses.
- 4. **Stable Acres** Connection to Micropulse private sewer- approximately 79 houses.
- 5. **Laud-** Connection to Micropulse or package treatment plant- approximately 50 homes in violation (there are more to the west, with newer septic systems).
- 6. **Blue River Estates-** Connection to Columbia City Sanitary Sewer- approximately 55 houses.
- 7. Wilson Lake- Connection to Columbia City via pump line- approximately 20 houses
- 8. **Collins** Connection to Columbia City or Package Treatment Plant- 37 houses, 1 business.
- 9. **Tunker** Package Treatment Plant- 22 houses, 1 business, and 1 church.
- 10. **Collamer** Connection to South Whitley Sanitary Sewer via pump line- approximately 33 houses in Collamer and along St. Rd. 14, 2 churches, and a church hall.
- 11. **Troy Cedar Lake** Connection to Tri-Lakes Sewer via Goose Lake- approximately 13 houses, 1 campground, and 1 children's camp.
- 12. **Etna** Connection to Tri-Lakes Sewer via Old Lake- approximately 31 houses in Etna and along 750 North.
- 13. **Magic Hills Addition** Connection to Tri-Lakes Sewer District- approximately 20 houses and one club house (some houses already connected to sewer).
- 14. **Northland Estates Addition-** Connection to Tri-Lakes Sewer District- approximately 40 houses.
- 15. **Chardonnay Addition-** Connection to Tri-Lakes Sewer District- approximately 16 houses.
- 16. **Fox Run-** Connection to Tri-Lakes Sewer District- approximately 16 houses.
- 17. **Ormas** Connection to Tri-Lakes Sewer District- approximately 16 houses.
- 18. Bear Lake- Connection to Tri-Lakes Sewer District.
- 19. Blue Lake Estates- Connection to Tri-Lakes Sewer District.
